## Josie Strife and her Troubled Life

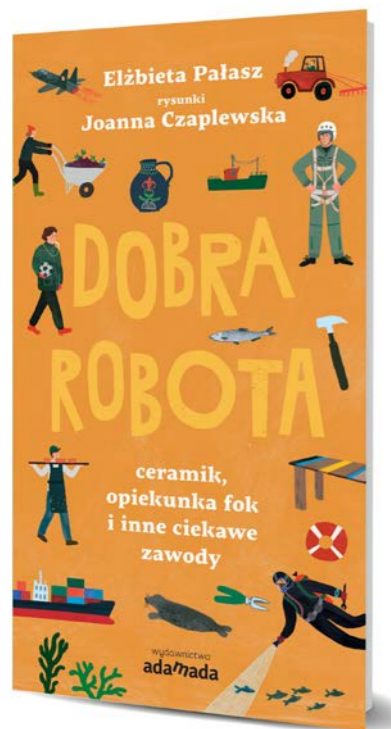
